#### **Smart LASIK**

## **Ultra LASIK Advanced**

Our gold standard for LASIK surgery. Ultra LASIK is a customized laser treatment which results in high-definition quality vision with faster healing and recovery rate. It is recommended for patients with high eye grades and astigmatism.

#### **Z Prime LASIK Pro**

It is usually recommended for those who wish to correct a mild degree of myopia (nearsightedness), hyperopia (farsightedness), or astigmatism.

## **Corneal Collagen Cross Linking (CXL)**

It is usually done in combination with any LASIK procedure to biomechanically strengthen thin corneas for a greater and lasting stability of vision over time.

## Thin Flap LASIK (TFL)

This is done in combination with any LASIK procedure for those with high eye grades and thin corneas to conserve corneal tissue.

## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:**

# What is the minimum age requirement for LASIK?

You need to be at least 18 years of age to have LASIK surgery. This is to make sure that your refractive error the amount of nearsightedness, farsightedness, and/or astigmatism - you have is stable and unlikely to worsen after your LASIK surgery.

## Is it painful?

No. The actual treatment is painless. Anesthetic drops will completely numb your eye. You may just feel a light pressure sensation around your eye. You may also be given a prescription for a pain reliever should you need it.

## How long does the LASIK procedure take?

The procedure usually takes around 10 minutes for both eyes. Depending on your prescription and needed correction, the laser itself only takes 20-50 seconds to correct your vision.

# How long will the effect of LASIK last?

Generally, the correction is permanent, especially if your eyeglass prescription was stable before you had LASIK. Shinagawa offers a 5-year LASIK warranty should there be any changes in the vision.

Over a million laser refractive surgeries are performed successfully worldwide each year. It has been proven to have a high safety profile with great results.
